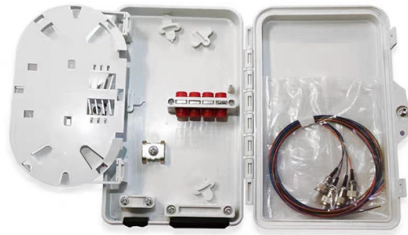


72-core optical cable color

- Fiber #12: Aqua fiber in the Blue tube
- Fiber #13: Blue fiber in the Orange tube
- Fiber #24: Aqua fiber in the Orange tube
- Fiber #72: Aqua fiber in the White tube

This system allows technicians to quickly locate and identify any fiber in a high-density cable, reducing errors during splicing or termination.

Additional Notes:

- Ribbon Cables:** If the 72-core cable uses ribbon fibers, the same 12-color sequence is applied to each ribbon within the buffer tube.
- Connector and Jacket Colors:** The outer jacket may indicate fiber type (single-mode or multimode), and connector boots often follow the same color coding for consistency.
- Stripes and Tracers:** For repeated colors in very high-count cables, black stripes or tracers may be added to maintain unique identification.

By following this tube + fiber color system, a 72-core optical cable can be efficiently managed, ensuring accurate splicing, testing, and maintenance.
