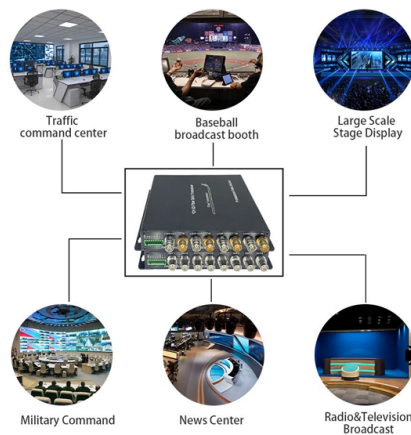


Adding a lintel to the opening of the distribution box

Lay wall to required height and opening. Set Lintel on block with 8" of bearing each end, minimum 4" - see GSN #5. Proceed as needed with the next course of. Steel Lintels should be installed with a minimum end bearing of 150mm, bedded on mortar and levelled along its length and across its width. Raise the inner and outer leaves simultaneously to avoid excessive. Lintels serve as critical structural elements above doors, windows, and arches, carrying loads from masonry to adjacent supports.
