- User-specific quotas: Assign explicit quotas to individual users or groups, ensuring fair allocation of storage resources.

These quotas help prevent a single user or service from consuming excessive storage, which could impact other users or critical applications.

Power Quotas Power quotas are critical for managing the electrical load of server racks:

- Kilowatts per rack (kW/rack): Define the maximum power each rack can draw based on the data center's electrical and cooling capacity.
- Power density considerations: High-density racks require careful planning to avoid overloading circuits and ensure adequate cooling. Typical colocation providers set limits according to server type, workload, and cooling efficiency.
- Monitoring and optimization: Track power usage effectiveness (PUE) to improve energy efficiency. Lower PUE values indicate better efficiency and help prevent unexpected power shortages.

Best Practices Combine storage and power quotas: Ensure that both disk space and power limits are enforced to maintain performance and prevent downtime.
