A successful basement cable tray installation requires careful planning, material verification, proper support, alignment, grounding, and adherence to safety and code standards.

1. Planning and Preparation Begin by reviewing approved shop drawings and coordinated layouts to determine tray routes, lengths, and locations within the basement (electrical rooms, service corridors, or plant areas). Confirm that all required materials, including cable trays, ladders, fittings, supports, hangers, bolts, and covers, are available and match approved submittals. Inspect materials for damage, corrosion, or coating defects and remove any unsuitable items from the site. 2. Material Handling and Storage Store cable trays and accessories in a dry, shaded area on a flat surface with timber supports at intervals of approximately one meter to prevent deformation. Keep materials free from dust, oil, and moisture, and cover them to protect from sunlight and environmental damage. Prepare a Material Inspection Request (MIR) for approval before installation.

3. Tray Type Selection Select the appropriate tray type based on cable type and environmental conditions:

- Ladder trays:** Ideal for power cables and large conductors; provide ventilation and easy cable anchoring.
- Ventilated trough trays:** Suitable for control and instrumentation cables; prevent sagging between rungs.
- FRP/composite trays:** Recommended in high-moisture or corrosive environments for non-conductive, corrosion-resistant support.

4. Installation Procedure Mark and align tray routes according to shop drawings, ensuring proper vertical and horizontal alignment using spirit or laser levels. Install supports such as trapeze hangers, cantilever brackets, or wall-mounted supports based on load calculations and manufacturer specifications
