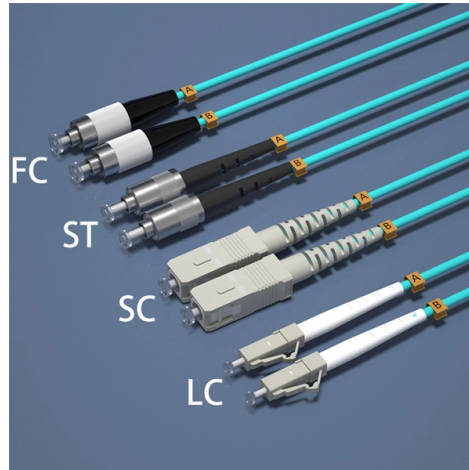


Bhutan Telecommunication Tower Installation



AI Overview

Telecommunication tower installation in Bhutan is governed by national standards and policies to ensure safety, connectivity, and environmental compliance, with ongoing projects expanding coverage in rural areas.

Regulatory Framework The Bhutan InfoComm and Media Authority (BICMA) has established the Standards for the Establishment of Telecommunications Towers, effective from July 1, 2021. These standards apply to all licensed ICT facility and service providers planning to build new Base Transceiver Stations (BTS), repeaters, monopole stations, and broadcasting towers. Key requirements include:

- Technical compliance:** Towers must meet structural safety standards and minimize exposure to Radio Frequency (RF) electromagnetic fields.
- Location compliance:** Towers should consider environmental and aesthetic impacts, including the use of camouflaged towers to blend with natural surroundings.
- Co-location:** Providers are encouraged to share tower infrastructure to reduce environmental footprint and improve efficiency.
- Public consultation:** Relevant agencies and local communities must be informed before deployment to ensure social acceptance and safety compliance.

Policy Context Bhutan's Telecommunications and Broadband Policy emphasizes connectivity for all, promoting private investment, competition, and affordable services. The policy recognizes that broadband development relies on robust telecommunication infrastructure, making tower installation a critical component for achieving a knowledge-based society and supporting socioeconomic development.

Recent Developments Telecom operators Bhutan Telecom and TashiCell are actively expanding tower infrastructure. For example, 16 additional towers are being installed in Samtse district to address poor network coverage in remote gewogs. This expansion aims to improve mobile and in...
