Power Off and Safety First: Disconnect all power sources, including batteries or mains, and verify circuits are de-energized. Wear insulated gloves and safety glasses.

Cable Termination: Use high-quality crimpers for terminal lugs and a torque wrench to tighten bolts to manufacturer specifications. Loose connections can generate heat and resistance.

Organized Layout: Route wires neatly to minimize clutter and reduce the risk of accidental shorts. Group similar circuits together and maintain proper spacing.

Connection to Busbar: Attach wires to the busbar using lugs or terminal blocks, ensuring firm mechanical and electrical contact. For three-phase systems, maintain correct phase sequence and color coding.

Protective Covers: Install insulating covers over exposed busbar sections to prevent accidental contact and short circuits.
