

Cable Tray Installation and Laying Techniques

Step 4: Install Supports and Mounting Secure the tray using brackets, wall arms, or trapeze hangers. Standard support spacing is typically 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on tray type and load. Ensure trays are level, straight, and properly aligned. For ceiling installations, use threaded rods and anchor bolts; for wall-mounted trays, use cantilever brackets.

Step 5: Lay Cables Load heavy cables first, followed by lighter control or data cables. Separate cables by voltage or function using dividers if necessary. Secure cables with ties or straps, leaving slack for expansion or future adjustments. Use rollers or sheaves for long runs to prevent kinks or jacket damage.

Step 6: Grounding and Bonding For metal trays, bond all sections to maintain electrical continuity. Use proper groundin...
