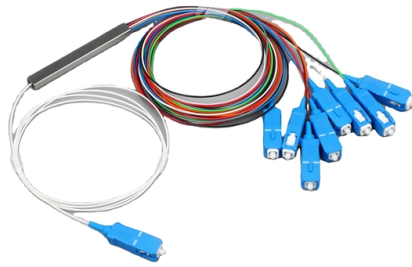

These systems use portals brazed or welded into the frame, into which aluminum inserts guide the cables. Components include: Housing guide inserts for smooth cable passage. Housing stop inserts to terminate cable housing. Wire routing inserts with rubber guides to protect wires.
