- Increase Support Frequency:** Reduce the distance between supports to minimize sag and lateral movement. For heavy loads, spacing may need to be less than 2 meters.
- Secure Cables Properly:** Use cable ties, Velcro straps, or clips to hold cables in place. Divider strips can separate power, data, and control cables, preventing uneven weight distribution.
- Select Appropriate Tray Type:** Ladder trays, mesh baskets, or thicker metal trays provide better mechanical strength and reduce movement under load.
- Check Installation Alignment:** Ensure trays are mounted correctly on the host structure. Wall-mounted or horizontal trays may require connectors or bends to maintain proper orientation and prevent shifting during installation.
- Avoid Overloading:** Calculate the total cable weight and ensure it does not exceed the tray's rated capacity. Consider separate routes for high-density or heavy cables.
