Place one round washer on each hanger rod and then lift tray section so that the threaded rod runs through the two holes in the clamp (SC). NEC Article 392 outlines the key rules for installing and maintaining industrial cable tray systems. These systems, made from metal or plastic, are open structures designed to support electrical conductors, ensuring proper organization and safety. Complicating the problem are overloaded trays and large unsupported spans. During forklift offloading on uneven ground, one must exercise extreme caution to prevent load shifting. A properly designed and installed cable tray system will provide. In practice, cable tray dimensions are a system of interrelated measurements —width, depth, length, and material thickness—that directly affect cable fill compliance, heat dissipation, structural loading, and long-term expandability.
