Cable trays and ventilation systems must be installed with sufficient clearance to avoid interference and ensure proper airflow. Section 318-4 Uses Not Permitted states that "Cable tray systems shall not be used in environmental air spaces except as permitted in Section 300-22 to support wiring methods recognized for use in such spaces. It is designed to carry and manage insulated electrical cables for power, data, communication, and control systems. The wiring methods allowed under Section 300-22 that utilize cable tray must follow the. The recommended safety distance between cable trays and other systems depends on the installation type, but in most projects: These clearances help prevent overheating, airflow blockage, and water damage, while ensuring safe operation and maintenance access.
