

Cable trays crossing passageways



AI Overview

Cable tray crossings allow safe, organized, and stable routing of multiple cable trays across passageways, ensuring compliance with load, fire, and structural standards. Purpose of Cable Tray Crossings Cable tray crossings, also called cross junctions or cross fittings, are designed to connect up to four cable trays horizontally at intersection points. They provide stable support for power, data, and control cables, maintain neat cable routing, and reduce installation time while improving system longevity and safety (Ekabel.24) . Materials and Standards Crossing fittings are typically made from galvanized steel, offering corrosion resistance and fire resistance class E90 per DIN 4102-12. They are CE-certified and compatible with standard cable tray systems, usually supporting tray widths from 100 mm to 300 mm and side heights of 60 mm (Ekabel.24) . Other materials like stainless steel, aluminum, or GRP may be used depending on environmental conditions, such as high humidity or corrosive atmospheres (Legrand, ABB) . Installation Guidelines Positioning: Align the cable trays to intersect at the desired crossing point. Securing: Insert the trays into the crossing fitting and fasten each side with screws to create a firm, vibration-resistant joint (Ekabel.24) . Support: Ensure the crossing is supported by wall brackets, ceiling suspensions, or floor mounts to handle the combined load of all intersecting trays (OBO CMS) . Spacing: Maintain proper rung spacing (typically 150–230 mm) to support cables and prevent sagging (ABB) . Clearance: Provide sufficient vertical and horizontal clearance in passageways to allow safe movement of personnel and equipment. Safety and Compliance Load Capacity: Verify that the crossing can support the total weight of all cables routed through it. Fire Safety: Use fire-resistant materials and maintain compliance with local fire codes. Accessibility: Ensure crossings do not obstruct emergency exits or create tripping hazards. Future Maintenance: Crossings should allow easy access for cable addition or replacement...
