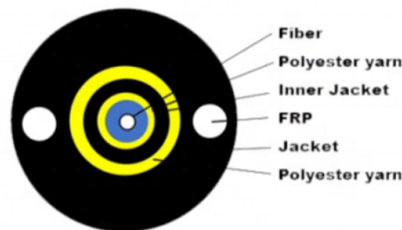


Cable trays for overhead installation

Use cable ties or clamps at regular intervals to secure cables and maintain spacing. Install markers or labels for easy identification and future maintenance.

Step 6: Ensure Safety and Compliance Follow bonding and grounding requirements to prevent electrical hazards. When passing through fire-rated walls or floors, use fire-stopping measures to prevent fire spread. Avoid overloading the tray to maintain h...
