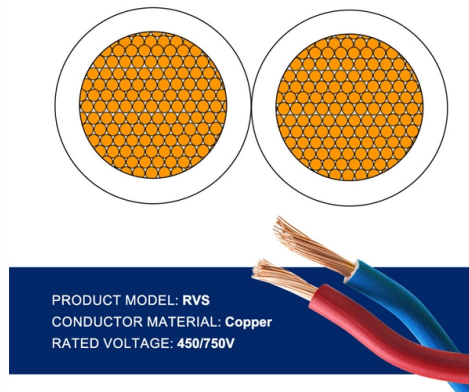

Cable shall be protected from physical damage where necessary by rigid metal conduit, intermediate metal conduit, electrical metallic tubing, Schedule 80 PVC conduit, or other. The option of placing electrical communications in the basement of the building has a number of positive aspects: The remoteness of the main part of the wiring from the residential areas of the house reduces the risk of electric shock.
