

Can a duplex optical module be used as a simplex module



Overview

Q: Can a duplex fiber cable be used in a simplex application?

A: Yes. They operate on a bidirectional transmission mechanism and have two distinct channels or ports for transmission and reception of data. However, the optical interfaces and transceivers at both ends must support the intended simplex. In data communication, transmission direction is generally divided into three basic modes: Simplex, Half-duplex, Full-duplex. These describe how devices communicate — not how many fibers are inside a cable. This is achieved using Wavelength Division Multiplexing (WDM), a technology that allows multiple wavelengths of light to travel in both. A duplex fiber-optic connector connects to two optical ports, whereas a simplex connector connects to a single optical port. At a basic level, simplex fiber contains one optical fiber strand, while duplex fiber contains two. However, real-world engineering deployments are far more nuanced.
