Configuration: The router may require ISP credentials or VLAN settings to establish a proper connection. Some fiber-ready routers have built-in SFP or WAN ports that can accept fiber modules directly, but even in this case, the router itself performs the conversion and routing functions; the fiber cable alone does not act as a router.
