- Immunity to interference:** Fiber is unaffected by electromagnetic or radio frequency interference, allowing safe installation near power lines and appliances.
- Future-proofing:** Fiber supports emerging technologies like 4K/8K streaming, virtual reality, and large cloud data transfers.

- Ethernet cables:** High-speed CAT6 or better cables connect the ONT to the router for stable data transfer.
