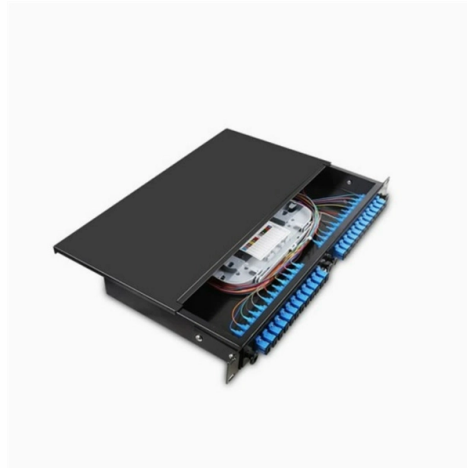


Can optical modules be used in a daisy-chain configuration
