

Can the ab ends of a single-mode fiber be interchanged



Overview

Short answer: Usually yes, you use them in pairs, but the “pair” can be a media converter on one end and a fiber switch (or SFP in a switch) on the other, as long as both sides speak the same speed, wavelength, and optical mode. The ab end of the fiber optic transceiver should be the transmitting end (a end) and the receiving end (b end). For BiDi single-fiber links, you still need A/B wavelength pairing. Then use a multimode fiber to connect the two ends. This is the most ideal and simple application scenario. What if end B is located in another building, dozens of kilometers far away from end A?

Or end B equipment is single-mode or must use a single-mode fiber connection?

In the former case, you. In many applications of fiber optics, it is necessary to connect fiber ends (terminations) in some way such that light from one fiber can get into the other fiber without losing too much of its optical power.
