Maintain bend radius according to manufacturer specifications to prevent signal loss .Termination and Splicing Connector termination: Strip protective layers, clean fiber end faces, and align precisely in connectors (SC, LC, ST, etc.) Fusion splicing: Align and weld fiber cores for minimal signal loss Always clean fiber end faces before con...
