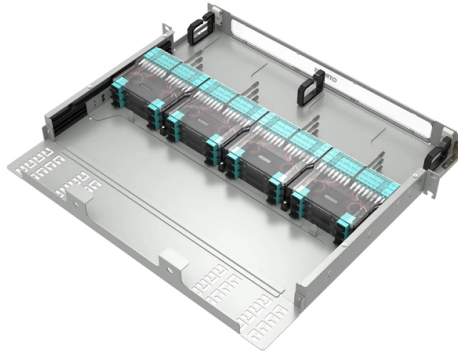


Carrier fiber optic connection to core switch

To connect a carrier fiber optic cable to a core switch, use the correct SFP/SFP+ transceiver, duplex fiber cabling, and ensure proper send/receive port alignment.

Step 1: Verify Switch Compatibility Ensure your core switch has available SFP or SFP+ ports compatible with the fiber type you plan to use (single-mode for long distances, multi-mode for shorter distances) and that the switch supports the required bandwidth (1G, 10G, or higher).

Step 2: Select the Correct SFP/SFP+ Module Choose an SFP transceiver module that matches the fiber optic cable type: Single-mode (OS2) for long-distance carrier connections Multi-mode (OM3/OM4) for shorter distances Ensure the module supports the switch's speed and duplex requirements.

Step 3: Prepare Duplex Fiber Cabling Carrier fiber connections typically require duplex (two-strand) fiber optic cables with LC connectors. You can use pre-terminated cables or terminate them in the field. Always ensure the connectors are clean to prevent signal loss.

Step 4: Connect the Fiber to the Switch Insert the SFP/SFP+ module into the switch port. These modules are usually hot-swappable, so the switch does not need to be powered down. Connect the duplex fiber cable to the SFP module. Ensure the send (TX) and receive (RX) fibers are correctly aligned: the TX of the switch connects to the RX of the carrier device and vice versa.

Step 5: Optional Patch Panel Integration If using a fiber patch panel, connect the fiber from the carrier to the patch panel first, then run a patch cable from the panel to the switch. This allows easier management and future maintenance.

Step 6: Verify the Connection After connecting, check the switch interface status to ensure the link is up and operational. Monitor for errors or signal loss, and confirm that the correct SFP module and fiber type are in use.
