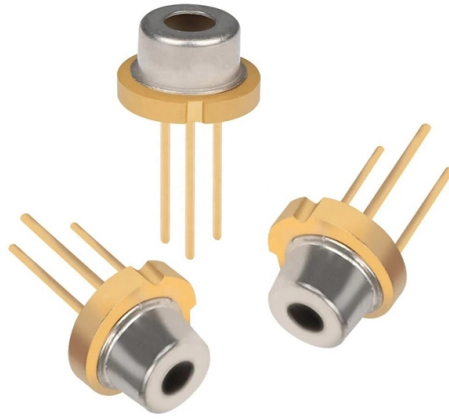

Trapeze Hangers and Cantilever Supports While these are primarily for supporting the tray, they can be integrated with engineered walkways or platforms to provide safe access points for maintenance personnel. Fall Protection Systems When working at height, use fall arrest systems anchored to structural supports, not the cable tray. Ensure compliance with OSHA fall protection standards. Installation and Maintenance Tips Plan Access Routes: During installation, consider future maintenance and include safe access points. Avoid Overloading: Do not place additional weight on trays beyond their rated load, as this can compromise structural integrity. Use Proper Tools: Cable pulling and maintenance should be done with tools designed for tray systems, avoiding climbing whenever possible.
