

Color of warning signs for cable trays



Overview

Cable trays containing conductors over 600 volts are required to be marked “Danger – High Voltage – Keep Away”. Depending on the specifications, the color is usually black print on white or yellow vinyl. It is quite common to see cable trays used to carry DC PV source circuits operating over 600 volts. Code Change Summary: New marking requirements were added for cable trays. They facilitate easy identification of different cables and pathways, reducing the risk of errors during maintenance or. Sunlight-resistant tray cables are governed by strict certifications that ensure durability and safe installation in outdoor environments. UL 1277 is one of the most important, requiring cables marked “Sunlight Resistant” or “SUN RES” to undergo testing for long-term UV exposure as well as physical. Power comes in from the electric utility on either a cable tray or some other raceway.

Cable trays containing conductors operating over 600 volts shall have a permanent, legible warning notice carrying the wording "DANGER -

392.18 (H) Cable Trays. Marking.

When cable trays contain conductors rated over 600 volts they are required to be marked "DANGER — HIGH VOLTAGE — KEEP AWAY" at no further than 10

Here's Your Sign

A permanent, legible, warning notice worded "Danger-High Voltage" must be placed in a conspicuous place at all entrances and access points to substations with a

How to Read Tray Cable Markings and Labels?
