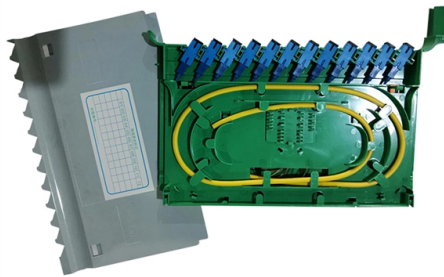

Use cable management techniques to keep wiring neat and organized, avoiding overlapping or tangled wires. Label each circuit clearly for easy identification during maintenance or troubleshooting.
