

Connect another router to the fiber optic box

To connect a router to a fiber optic box, you need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) and an Ethernet cable linking the ONT to your router's WAN port.

Regularly monitor internet speed and update firmware to maintain performance. By following these steps, your router will be properly connected to the fiber optic box, providing high-speed, low-latency internet throughout your home or office.

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
