

Connecting multiple PoE switches to multiple fiber optic transceivers

Choosing the Right Fiber and Transceivers

Polarity: When connecting duplex fiber, reverse the transmit and receive connections between switches (A to B, B to A) to maintain proper signal flow.

Network Topology Options

Star Topology: All switches connect to a central core switch. This reduces collisions and simplifies management but requires more fiber strands.

Cascade/Tree Topology: Switches are connected in series or hierarchical layers. Recommended for campus networks, but limit cascades to 4 layers to avoid latency and signal degradation.

Hybrid Topology: Combines star and cascade for flexibility in larger networks.

Cabling and Installation Tips

Duplex Fiber Cables: Always use duplex (two-strand) fiber for SFP modules. Multi-strand cables can support multiple connections simultaneously.

Pre-terminated Cables: Save time and reduce errors by using pre-terminated fiber cables with LC connectors.

Distance Considerations: Ensure the fiber type and SFP module support the required distance. For example, OM2 multimode fiber supports up to 550 meters at 1G, while single-mode fiber can reach several kilometers.

Compatibility Checks: Verify that all switches' optical modules have matching mode (single/multi), wavele...
