

Connecting the switch s optical port to the network card

Ensure the connectors match the transceiver type, typically LC connectors for SFP/SFP+ modules.

Step 3: Install the Transceivers Handle with care: Wear an ESD wrist strap and avoid touching the fiber ends. Insert the SFP/SFP+ module into the switch port and the NIC port. These modules are usually hot-swappable, so powering down is not required.

Check orientation: Ensure the module slides in smoothly; do not force it.

Step 4: Connect the Fiber Cable Attach the fiber optic patch cable to the transceiver on the switch and the NIC. Follow outbound to inbound convention: the transmit (TX) port on one end connects to the receive (RX) port on the other. Keep connectors clean and dust-free to prevent signal loss; clean with proper fiber cleaning tools if necessary.

Step 5: Configure the Network Power on the switch and NIC. Configure the switch port and NIC with the correct IP addresses, VLANs, and speed settings as required by your network. For switches with uplink modules, ensure all ports in a speed group operate at the same speed to avoid errors.
