- Modularity:** Adjustable DIN rails and modular slots allow flexible installation of circuit breakers and switches, accommodating future expansion.
- Cable Management:** Rear cable entrances with brushes or grommets help organize wiring and reduce dust or moisture ingress.
- Mounting Options:** Wall-mounted, pole-mounted, or rack-mounted designs can be chosen based on site requirements.
