For commercial or industrial applications, higher-rated switches may be required. Voltage Rating: The switch must match the supply voltage, e.g., 230V AC for single-phase domestic systems in India or 110-120V AC in the USA. Type of Device: Double-pole MCBs are standard for main switches, while single-pole MCBs are used for individual circuits. RCCBs are added downstream for protection a...
