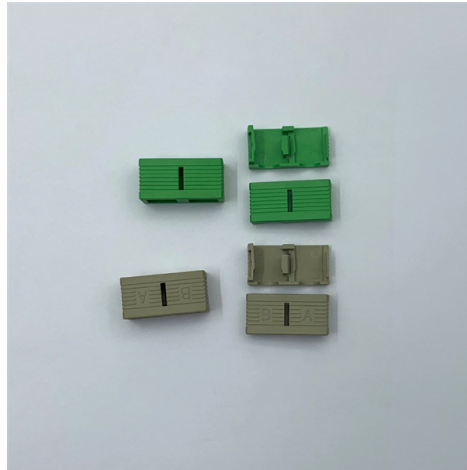


Diagram of cable tray structure
