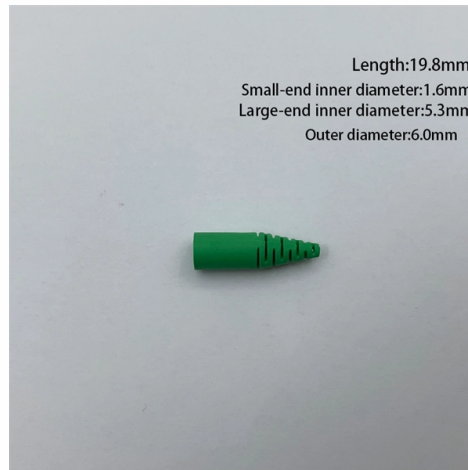


Distance of outdoor distribution box from the ground

Horizontal and vertical clearances are also important: the distance between the distribution box and the switch box should not exceed 30 meters, and the horizontal distance to controlled equipment should not exceed 3 meters to reduce line losses and improve efficiency. Maintain uniform height for similar enclosures within the same facility, with deviations no greater than 10 millimeters.
