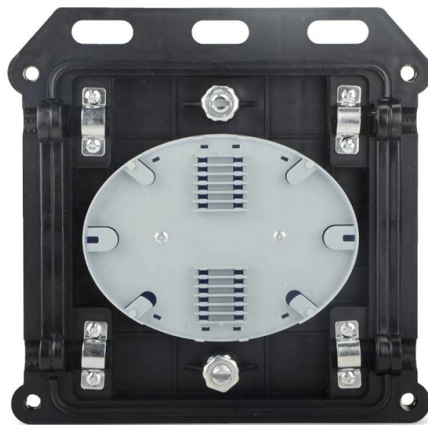

Adequate clearance around panels, typically at least 30 inches wide and 36 inches deep, to allow safe access. Overcurrent protection using circuit breakers or fuses to prevent thermal overloads and fire hazards. Support for large feeders and integration with modern systems like solar arrays, EV chargers, and smart-home devices. Prohibition of storing flammable materials inside or near the distribution box. Utility-Level Distribution Protection At the utility level, distribution systems typically operate below 34 kV and are fed from substations via step-down transformers. Protection strategies include: Phase and ground overcurrent relays for low-side tie breakers, often supplemented with directional overcurrent relays and automatic tie control schemes. Maximum fault current limits, commonly set at 10,000 Amps, to prevent equipment damage and maintain system stability. Load unbalance monitoring, measured at feeder breakers or transformer secondaries, to prevent uneven current distribution and potential overheating. Vegetation management and right-of-way expansion to reduce the risk of outages caused by fallen trees or environmental hazards. Specialized Enclosures and Hazardous Locations For industrial or hazardous environments, distribution boxes may require explosion-proof or Class I/II Division 2...
