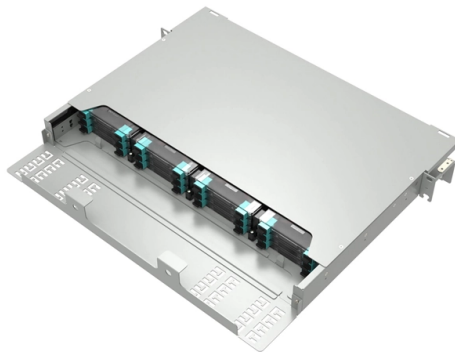

  - Component grounding:** Electrical components inside the box that require grounding should be connected to the PE bar using separate copper wires.
  - System grounding:** Attach a ground wire from the box's mounting plate to the central factory grounding point. The total ground resistance should be less than 0.1 Ohm for effective protection.
  - Wire routing:** Ensure neat cable management, secure connections, and no loose wires to maintain reliable grounding.

  - Testing:** Measure ground resistance after installation to confirm it meets specifications.
