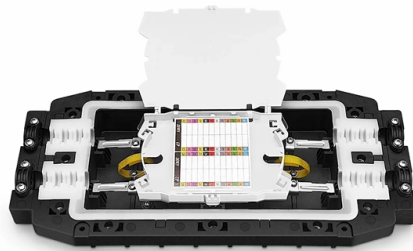

The ground resistance between all system parts should be very low, typically below 0.1 ohm for industrial applications, and below 25 ohms for general installations. Multiple grounding rods may be used if resistance is too high, and all connections should ensure good contact and corrosion resistance, especially in stainless steel enclosures. Practical Considerations Use high-quality materials like copper-bonded steel rods to prevent corrosion and maintain long-term safety. Ensure all moving parts, such as doors or hinges, are bonded with flexible copper tape to maintain consistent grounding. Test grounding effectiveness with a voltmeter after installation to confirm compliance with safety standards. Properly grounded distribution boxes act as the safety backbone of an electrical system, ensuring that electrical faults are safely dissipated and that both equipment and personnel are protected from hazards.
