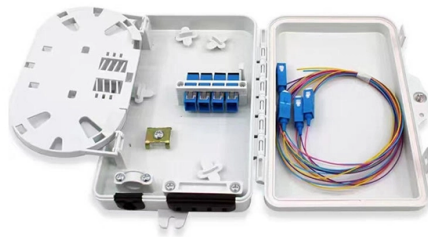

The DB box acts as the central hub, ensuring organized and safe power management. Connection Between Poles and Distribution Boxes Electric poles feed electricity into distribution boxes through service drops, which are the lines connecting the pole to the building's electrical system. Transformers mounted on poles step down high-voltage electricity from the distribution lines to a lower voltage suitable for residential or commercial use. Insulators on the pole prevent electricity from flowing into the pole itself, while ground wires protect against surges and light...
