- Box Fill and Sizing:** The internal volume must accommodate all conductors, devices, and clamps. NEC Table 314.16(A) specifies cubic-inch allowances per conductor based on wire gauge, with additional volume for devices and grounding.
- Material and Grounding:** Metal boxes must be grounded and are required when using metal conduit or armored cable. Nonmetallic boxes are used with nonmetallic sheathed cable (NM-B) in most residential wood-frame construction.
- Weight and Fixture Support:** Standard boxes support up to 50 pounds; fan-rated boxes can support up to 70 pounds. Heavier fixtures require independent structural support.
- Environmental Considerations:** Outdoor or wet-location boxes must be moisture-resistant and suitable for environmental exposure.
