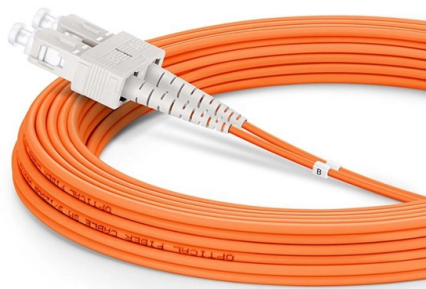

Incoming Power Connection: Connect the live (phase) wire to the main terminal and the neutral wire to the neutral busbar. Ground wires should be connected to the grounding bar.

Circuit Breaker Installation: Place circuit breakers in their designated slots. Connect each outgoing circuit wire to its corresponding breaker, ensuring correct polarity and secure connections.

Wire Management: Use neat cable routing, proper insulation, and correct wire gauge for the load. Label all wires for easy identification and future maintenance.

Testing: After wiring, perform visual inspections and multimeter tests to check for short circuits, loose connections, or incorrect wiring.

- Use UL/CE-certified components and comply with local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or regional standards).
- Include protection devices like surge protectors and fuses for each circuit.
