- Protective Relays** Relays act as the “brains” of the protection system, sensing abnormal conditions like overcurrent, voltage deviations, or unbalanced loads, and signaling breakers to trip, thereby isolating the affected circuit.
- Surge Protectors** Surge protection devices guard against transient overvoltages caused by lightning strikes, switching operations, or other disturbances, preventing damage to sensitive equipment.

Additional Components and Features

- Busbars:** Metal bars that efficiently distribute power to multiple circuits within the DB box.
- Indication Lights:** Provide visual status of mains power supply and circuit conditions.
- Smart Modules:** Modern DB boxes may include energy monitoring units and communication modules for real-time data collection, remote control, and...
