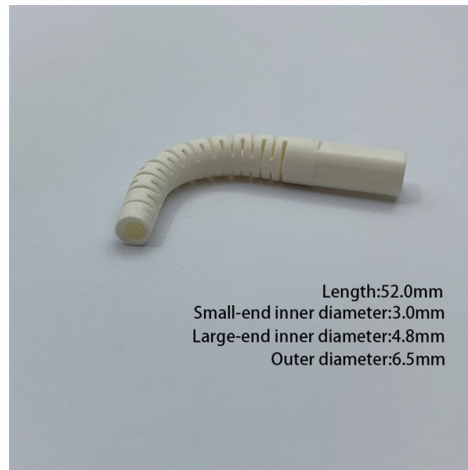

Network cabinets should comply with standardized dimensions, rack unit spacing, mounting, ventilation, and grounding requirements as defined by TIA/EIA, IEC, and ETSI standards. Cabinet and Rack Types Network cabinets are typically 19-inch racks, available as four-post EIA cabinets or two-post Telco racks, conforming to ANSI/EIA-310-D-1992 standards for universal hole spacing. Wall-mounted cabinets follow the same 19-inch width standard, ensuring compatibility with rack-mounted equipment from multiple manufacturers. Cabinets are available in multiples of rack units (RU), where 1 RU equals 1.75 inches (44.45 mm), with common sizes including 6U, 9U, 12U, 18U, and 24U. Physical Installation Requirements Vertical space: Minimum 1 RU per chassis, with front-to-back rail spacing of 23.5–34 inches (59.7–86.4 cm) for four-post racks. Front clearance: Minimum 3 inches (7.6 cm) from front door to mounting rails; 5 inches (12.7 cm) if cable management brackets are installed. Side clearance: At least 2.5 inches (6.4 cm) between chassis and cabinet walls. Mounting rails: Must support proper cable bend radius and secure equipment installation.
