Fibre Discs (Grinding Applications) For fibre discs used in metal grinding, the hole size refers to the arbor or mounting hole that fits the angle grinder or backing pad. Standard fibre discs typically have 7/8 inch (22.23 mm) arbor holes for most grinders, though some discs may have 5/8 inch (16 mm) or 1 inch (25.4 mm) holes depending on the tool manufacturer. Correct hole sizing ensures the disc is securely mounted, spins true, and delivers optimal cutting or grinding performance. Using the wrong hole size can lead to vibration, uneven wear, or unsafe operation. Key Considerations For HDD fiber installation: Always check the duct diameter, soil type, and pullback method to determine the correct bore size. Oversizing can increase cost, while undersizing risks cable damage. For fibre discs: Match the disc hole to the grinder arbor and use the recommended backup pad for best performance. Coarse discs with firm pads provide faster material removal, while finer discs give smoother finishes.
