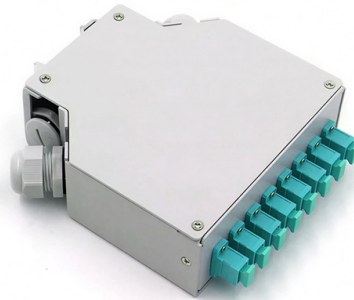


Fiber Optic Cable Box Making

Worksite Preparation Once approvals are secured, crews prepare the worksite by marking existing underground utilities such as water, gas, and electric lines. This prevents accidental damage during trenching or drilling.

Cable Installation

Underground Installation For underground fiber, trenches are dug using traditional trenching, microtrenching, or directional drilling depending on urban density and terrain. Conduits, typically plastic or steel, are placed to protect and organize the fiber cables. Fiber is then pulled or blown through the conduits using specialized equipment. Microtrenching is minimally invasive, creating narrow, shallow trenches that reduce disruption and cost.

Aerial Installation In areas where underground installation is impractical, fiber is deployed aerially on utility poles. Cables are attached using clamps and spacers, and overlashing may be used to attach new fiber to existing power lines, reducing the need for new poles.
