Fiber optic cables have a measurable carbon footprint, with production emissions estimated at approximately 72.92 kg CO₂ per kilogram of fiber, and life cycle assessments show FTTH networks are significantly more sustainable than hybrid alternatives. Carbon Footprint of Fiber Optic Cables The production of fiber optic cables generates greenhouse gas emissions primarily during the manufacturing phase. A standardized estimate indicates 4.81 tonnes CO₂ equivalent per million meters of fiber produced, which translates to 72.92 kg CO₂ per kilogram of fiber. These emissions include energy consumption in production, raw material extraction, and transportation of components. Life cycle assessments (LCA) often consider the cradle-to-gate or cradle-to-shelf scope, capturing the environmental impact from raw materials to the finished product ready for deployment. Life Cycle Assessment and Sustainability Fiber optic cables are evaluated using LCA methodologies based on international standards such as the GHG Protocol and ISO 14064. These assessments account for all stages, including: Raw material extraction Cable manufacturing Transportation and installation Operational energy use End-of-life disposal or recycling Studies show that fiber-to-the-home (FTTH) networks have a lower overall carbon footprint compared to hybrid fiber-coaxial (HFC) networks. Specifically, FTTH networks have 60% less embodied carbon, 7% lower installation emissions, and up to 96% lower operational carbon footprint, while customer premise equipment emissions are also reduced by 18%. This demonstrates that fiber networks are a more sustainable choice for broadband infrastructure.
