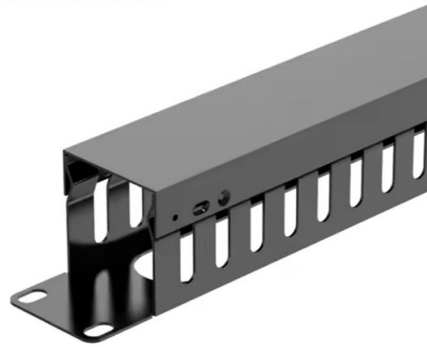

This system offers the lowest latency path between the two nations and is planned for Ready for Service in Q4 2028, with a Hawaii branch following in 2029 .Via Africa and TalayLink Projects: Recent initiatives include the Via Africa cable to enhance Europe-Africa connectivity and the TalayLink project in Thailand, which features a conduit capable of housing 11 separate subsea cables, demonstrating the scale and complexity of modern sub-projects .Technical and Strategic ConsiderationsTechnology: Modern projects use high-count fiber pairs, wavelength division multiplexing (WDM), and advanced optical amplifiers to maximize bandwidth and reliability .Deployment: Companies like SubCom manage the full lifecycle, from manufacturing and integration to subsea installation using sp...
