

Fiber Optic Switch Module Wiring



AI Overview

Proper wiring of a fiber optic switch communication module involves connecting power, selecting compatible fiber cables, and configuring the network via GUI or panel interface.

Power and Mounting Most fiber optic modules, such as Siemens FN2013-U1/FN2014-U1 or High-Speed Network Communications Modules (HS-NCM), require 24 VDC power, which can be supplied directly from the control panel or via a UL-listed external power supply. For industrial switches like the 8x8 MEMS fiber optic switch, connect the 100–240 AC power supply to the rear panel and verify the green LED on the front panel to confirm power. Modules can be mounted in standard enclosures or card cages, depending on the model, using mounting plates if necessary.

Fiber Cabling Select the correct fiber type: Single-mode or multi-mode depending on module specifications. For Siemens FN2014-U1, use duplex 50/125 μm or 62.5/125 μm fiber-optic cables with SC connectors.

Topology options: Modules can operate in daisy chain or star configurations, allowing flexible network layouts.

Compatibility: Ensure fiber transceivers are compatible with the switch or module. Using non-compatible SFPs can cause link instability.

Network Connections For modules with Ethernet-based control (e.g., 8x8 MEMS switch), connect a twisted-pair Ethernet cable from the module to a computer. Configure the computer to the same IP segment as the module. Access the module's web GUI using the default IP (e.g., 192.168.0.3) and login credentials (default: admin/admin). Disable DHCP and assign a static IP address to ensure consistent access.

For fire alarm communication modules (HS-NCM), connect the module to the panel via fiber-optic ports and ensure NUP port connections are made for supervised communication.

Configuration and Operation Use the GUI or panel interface to set switch positions, loop sequences, and timing for optical paths. Monitor input/output power levels in real-time to verify signal integrity. For modules acting as repeaters, ensure proper network addressing and n...
