ADSS cables are lightweight, self-supporting, and designed to withstand extreme weather, UV exposure, and mechanical stress, making them ideal for aerial deployment alongside power lines.
- 3. Optical Power Attached Cable (OPAC):** OPAC cables are lightweight, all-dielectric fibers that are wrapped or lashed around existing power conductors. Installation often uses specialized equipment to helically wrap the cable along the conductor, a method sometimes called "Sky-Wrap." OPAC is suitable for long spans and high towers, with cable jackets designed to resist abrasion, temperature extremes, and ice buildup.

**Installation Methods**

- Helical Wrapping:** A robotic or mechanical system can wrap fiber optic cables around powerline conductors while moving along the line. This method allows the cable to follow the existing right-of-way and avoids the need for additional poles or infrastructure.
- Pole Attachment:** ADSS cables can be mounted on existing poles using non-metallic hardware, enabling single-pass installation without reinforcing the poles.
- Ground Wire Integration:** OPGW is installed as the top ground wire on transmission towers, providing...
