- Cleave the fiber:** Use a precision fiber cleaver to create a clean, perpendicular cut on the fiber end, which is essential for low-loss splicing.
- Insert into the connector:** Place the prepared fiber into the ferrule of the cold splice connector, ensuring precise alignment with the fiber stub inside the connector.
- Secure the connection:** Lock the ferrule into the connector body to maintain alignment and provide a stable mechanical connection.

Cold splicing is widely used in FTTH deployments, emergency repairs, and small-scale installations where fusion splicing is impractical. Key advantages include:

- Quick installation:** Typically completed in minutes without specialized fusion equipment.
- Lower tool cost:** Requires only basic preparation tools and connectors.
- Field flexibility:** Ideal for patching, drop cables, or temporary connections.

Performance Considerations

- Attenuation:** Cold splices generally have higher light loss than fusion splices, typically around 0.1–0.3 dB per point, but can be acceptable for short-term or low-demand applications.
