Step 4: Route Fiber Cables Identify the fiber input holes (centered or U-shaped) and route cables in a clockwise direction to prevent stress on fibers. Use flex tubes or protective horns at entry points to guide pigtails and loose tubes safely into the tray. Apply foam tape around flex tubes and secure cables with tie-wraps at hinge plates and platforms to prevent movement.

Step 5: Secure Devices and Protective Covers Mount devices such as patch panels or transceivers onto the tray or cabinet, ensuring they lock securely with the tray base. Install protective covers to shield fibers from dust and mechanical damage. Verify that all fasteners are tight, trays are level, and cables are properly supported witho...
