- Optical Power Splitting:** Houses PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit) splitters to divide a single optical signal into multiple outputs for multiple subscribers.
- Fiber Termination and Splicing:** Provides a protected environment for splicing feeder fibers to drop cables and connecting patch cords.
- Flexible Distribution:** Enables routing of optical signals to different subscriber lines while maintaining signal integrity.
