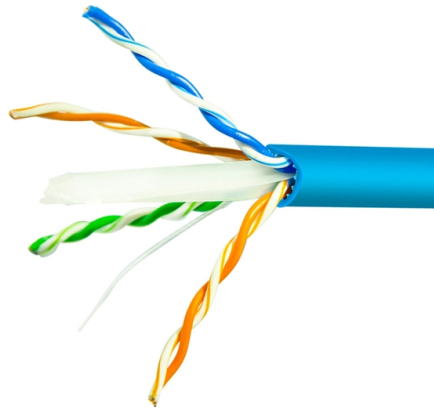


Fiber optic router light

5. WLAN / Wi-Fi Light
Flickering: Wireless activity is occurring.
Off: Wi-Fi is disabled in router settings.
6. Internet / WAN Light
Solid Green/Blue: Router is connected to the internet.
Flashing: Data is being transmitted.
Red or Off: No internet connection; may indicate ISP issues or misconfigured settings.

Troubleshooting Tips

- All lights off: Ensure the router is plugged in and the outlet has power.
- Only power light on: Router may be faulty; consider restarting or contacting support.
- No internet despite all lights normal: Check for ISP outages or account/service issues.
- Blinking PON or LOS red: Inspect fiber cables for damage, clean connectors, or contact your provider.

Understanding these LED indicators allows you to quickly identify whether the issue is with your router, connected devices, or the fiber network itself, and take appropriate action to restore connectivity.
