Optical Distribution Network (ODN): Fiber cables that carry data from the OLT to neighborhoods, often using optical splitters to serve multiple homes. Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Installed at the home, it converts light signals into digital data for use with a compatible router or Wi-Fi system. Installation usually involves running fiber from a distribution hub to the home, terminating at an external box, and connecting to the ONT inside. The process typically takes 2-4 hours, depending on property layout and provider procedures. Advantages of FTTH High bandwidth: Supports gigabit and multi-gigabit speeds for multiple devices simultaneously. Low latency: Ideal for gaming, video calls, and real-time applications.
